## THE CHALLENGE

The **SOCAL STEAM Challenge** is a three-day educational event where local high school students design, build, and race 16-foot solar-powered boats at Yucaipa Regional Park. This hands-on experience promotes engineering, teamwork, and water sustainability.

Over six months, students work on their boats at school with guidance from dedicated instructors. Teams also submit technical reports and create a water conservation Public Service Announcement (PSA).

At the event, boats compete in endurance, slalom, and sprint races. Teams earn points across all activities, and the highest-scoring team wins.

Funded by local utilities and companies, the SOCAL STEAM Challenge inspires the next generation of innovators.



# PSA CHALLENGE WATER CONSERVATION

California's "Making Conservation a California Way of Life" regulation sets long-term goals to improve water efficiency in response to climate change and frequent droughts. Residential indoor water use must be reduced to 47 gallons per person per day (GPCD) by 2025, and 42 GPCD by 2030. Water suppliers must work with their communities to meet these goals.

For this year's PSA, student teams will calculate one student's daily water footprint and determine whether it meets the 47 GPCD standard. Teams will present their findings, explain how the water was used, and either propose a plan to reduce usage or describe steps already taken to stay in compliance. Students must also suggest ways to reach the future target of 42 GPCD by 2030.
